Authorization and Eligibility Requirements – Adopted Plan and Proof of Formal Adoption

Adopted Plan and Proof of Formal Adoption

The Coachella Valley IRWM Region updated its 2010 IRWM Plan from 2012 through March 2014 consistent with the *2012 IRWM Grant Program Guidelines*¹ and CWC §10543, as described in Chapter 7 of the 2014 IRWM Plan. The 2014 IRWM Plan was finalized in March 2014, and formally adopted by Coachella Valley Regional Water Management Group (CVRWMG) agencies' governing bodies. The 2014 IRWM Plan was submitted to DWR on April 9, 2014. DWR issued the Draft Review of the Coachella Valley IRWM Plan on June 2, 2014 which initiated the beginning of the 30-day public comment period. DWR issued a Final Review to CVWD on July 2, 2014, indicating that no comments had been received and that DWR had determined that the Coachella Valley IRWM Plan is consistent with the IRWM Planning Act and the related IRWM Plan Standards contained in the 2012 IRWM Program Guidelines.

Information below describes the status of IRWM Plan Adoption for each project proponent of the projects included within this *Coachella Valley 2015 IRWM Implementation Grant Proposal*. Per terms of the Proposal Solicitation Package, those proponents that submitted proof of adoption with the 2014 IRWM Drought Grant Solicitation have been indicated below and proof of adoption for those proponents has not been re-submitted. The adoption resolutions for those proponents that did not previously submit information with the 2014 IRWM Drought Grant Solicitation are included as **Appendix 1-2** to this attachment.
